School Enhancement Program (SEP)

(Program formerly called **Routine Capital**)

Goal of the program:

- To fund projects that will extend the useful life of our facilities and school-based assets

School Districts can submit projects based on the following criteria:

- Maximum of five projects
- Submissions must be submitted by 15 April 2016
- Ministry will respond by 31 May 2016
- All projects must be completed by 31 March 2017

Eligible projects may include the following types of projects:

- Health & Safety Upgrades
- Mechanical Upgrades
- Electrical Upgrades
- Energy Upgrades
- Roofing Upgrades
